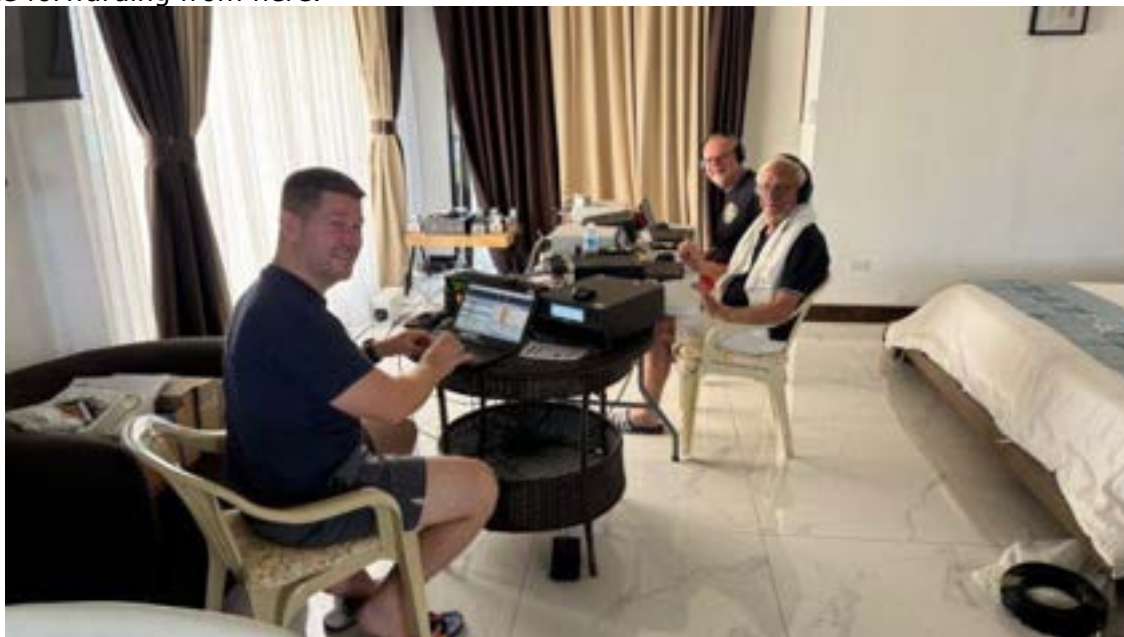
V6D Federated States of Micronesia -update September 25 by Rolf DL7VEE

After three days, we have over 20,000 QSOs in the log, even though we are not yet QRV on all bands.

Unfortunately, the missing luggage with the two-element wire beam and the fifth station has not yet arrived. We check with TKK Airport on Chuuk every day. That's why we improvised today and set up additional single-band wire antennas for 160, 17, and 10m using our spare equipment. We will try 160m tonight.

The weather is hot and humid with occasional storms and heavy rain.

Our log is online at Club Log and is updated at least once a day. Most of the time, the [V6D livestream](#) runs with all four stations. The QSOs currently being made are displayed with a delay of a few seconds. One station is used most of the day for CQ in FT8 on 50.313 MHz. We are very pleased with the good openings on 6m towards Japan and China. 80m is also working quite well. The team is in good shape and highly motivated, and is still hoping for the arrival of the missing radio equipment. The two pieces of luggage are at Tokyo Haneda Airport. It is not easy to organize forwarding from here.



FP5KE Saint-Pierre & Miquelon -update September 24

Yesterday, after 7 days of activity, FP5KE crossed the symbolic milestone of 100,000 QSOs; more than half of which are in human modes (CW, SSB & RTTY).

With almost 85K QSOs in the log, earlier today the PJ7K team donated a Spiderbeam antenna to local operator Airon PJ7AR. Tomorrow, September 22, the team will start to dismantle antennas and plan to go QRT around 1000z on Tuesday (23rd).



VP2MAA Montserrat -update by Franco VP2MAA / J88BTI

My departure for Montserrat is now scheduled for Wednesday, 24th September. VP2MAA will be on the air by 00.00 of the 25th CW-SSB-FT8. The initial antennas will be a horizontal loop for 40 meters, working on 6 to 40 and an inverted V for 80 meters, same as J88BTI.

Montserrat is ranking #71, data modes, in Club Log's most wanted list. I will try to satisfy that request with an ongoing 24 hours operation, while dedicating as much time as possible to the so called human modes. Do not expect too much activity on 6 meter at the moment, but the good news is that Steve, HA0DU is donating a 4 elements beam that should reach me at the beginning of October.

3G0XQ San Ambrosio Island -update by Felipe XQ7IR

After having a successful and exciting expedition last month on Islote Pájaros IOTA SA-100 (3G1P), I am pleased to report that the San Ambrosio (CE0X) project continues with important progress in the mission to put this exciting and rare entity "ON AIR".

A few days ago, I participated in two important meetings with the authorities responsible for granting permits and authorizations for this expedition to the Desventuradas Islands, so I'm in position to share the following information:

— Dates: The authorized dates for this Dx-Activity will be between January 12, 2026, and February 15, 2026, which represents at least 25 days of operation on the island.

3C2MD Equatorial Guinea -postponed

We sadly announce to Amateur Radio community that 3C2MD, our long awaited expedition to Equatorial Guinea, will be postponed to unknown future date because a sudden stop to all the Amateur Radio licenses declared by the local Government.

The reason of that decision has been due to "problems with license granted to two foreigner citizens" that, according to the local news, tried to operate from "sensitive part of the country" without all the necessary permissions in the early part of September. You may already have seen the online press articles about this fact. Because of their behaviour, the two foreigners had been obliged to stop their radio operations, so they decided to go back home before they had planned to.
