CQWW SSB CONTEST

This coming weekend sees one of the biggest DX contests of the year – CQWW SSB. Even if you're not a contester, there's usually something "juicy" to work on the bands, especially now sunspots and solar flux are generally higher than previous years.

If participating in the CQWW (SSB or CW) let **ADXO** know. Alternatively, keep an eye on that list nearer the time to see which DX stations will be on the bands before, after and during the contest.

Meanwhile, here's the **rules**.

FP5KE Saint-Pierre & Miquelon -update

We are experiencing some issues with the FP5KE log. Based on your correction requests, we noticed that some bands were recorded incorrectly. This happened when we shut down the stations to switch between generators. After restarting, the CAT control did not always reconnect properly and some QSOs were logged on an incorrect band for a period of time. PJ6Y Saba -update October 22

We are extremely pleased with the continued amazing propagation on all bands, with 20 and 17 meters open around the clock!

We are experiencing great openings on 160 and 80 to Europe, as well as good openings on 80 to JA, shares Gregg W6IZT. With good conditions on the low bands, we will focus on 160 and 80 during the evening hours. Yesterday afternoon we put approximately 50 stations in the log on 6 meters from NA, SA, and EU.

We are very fortunate to have a stellar operating location on the island. However, it is a relatively small site, and we feel that we are making the most of the limited area that we have to work with.

J38W Grenada -update

I am thrilled to announce that preparations for my upcoming DXpedition to Grenada, designated as J38W, are well underway. With just 33 days to go until my departure, I've ramped up my preparations in recent weeks.

My journey began in the picturesque Shropshire countryside, where I dedicated a day to set up the masts I intend to use. I meticulously arranged the guy ropes and laid the foundations for the antenna itself. XF4 Revillagigedo -update

Mark, XE1B will be returning to Revillagigedo for a short visit to meet the new base commander and set the conditions for an international team with remote capabilities for the future. Access to the base is severely restricted and only via a Navy battleship making supply runs from Baja, Mexico. The next Navy trip is scheduled for a 23 October departure from Socorro and a return on the 30th of October. That will allow Mark a 5 day window of operating (it's a 36 hour trip). Mark is a 3 time veteran of trips there, having activated XF4 in 1999, 2011, and 2018. He has a new license for this trip (the callsign will be released when he is QRV). He also has permission from the Navy and the other two regulatory agencies to visit the island and operate.

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3Y0K Bouvet Island -update by Ken LA7GIA

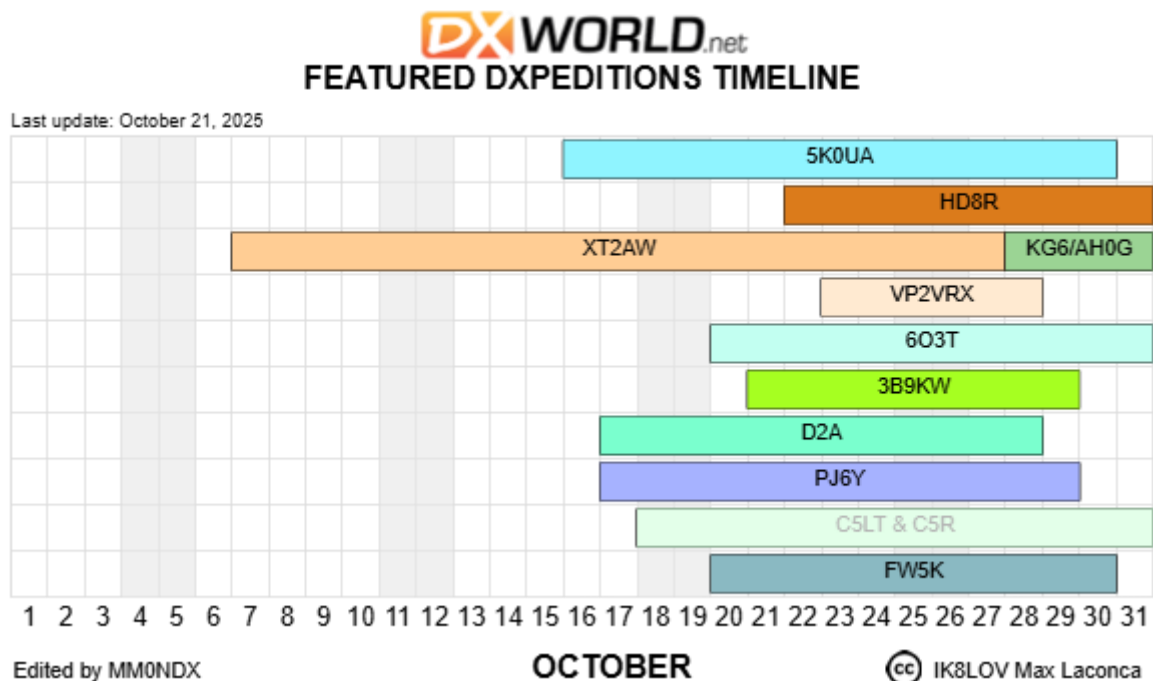

This includes a series of planning meetings to finalize logistics and camp setup—our top priority at the moment. Next month, we'll be making the final vessel deposit of approximately \$500,000. By that point, our total investment in this DXpedition will exceed \$1.5 million.
