The end of this month sees one of the biggest DX contests of the year – CQWW CW. Even if you're not a contester, there's usually something "juicy" to work on the bands. Will 10m be as good as the CQWW SSB contest last month?

If participating let ADXO know. Alternatively, keep an eye on that list nearer the time to see which DX stations will be on the bands before, after and during the contest.

DX News

PJ5C Sint Eustatius -update November 23

We arrived according to plan on Friday (Nov 21) late afternoon. Unfortunately, the antenna bag was missing. We ran Saturday on the DX-Commander to make at least a start. Sunday morning all antennas were up and running including 160/80m. We run barefoot but we will give all the bands a try this week. Although internet is fine, Club Log experiences regular log update issues and the stream stops. No worries as we will replace the data with our actual log regularly. Looking forward to meet you on the band (in CW or FT).

Norwegian territories -remote restrictions

Norway proposes new restrictions to remote operation. The regulator for amateur radio activity in Norway is the Norwegian Communications Authority (Nkom) and on the 24th of November 2025, they announced [proposed] restrictions on remote control of amateur radio stations 'Remote control of amateur radio station. Nkom has registered a growing interest in the use of remote control of amateur radio stations via the internet. This use is increasing in scope and users are constantly finding new "applications" for remote control of amateur radio stations. Nkom therefore sees the need to regulate this type of use. To prevent abuse, it is proposed to ban remote control of amateur radio stations if the amateur radio operator is not physically located on the same land area, which is e.g. mainland Norway, Svalbard, Bjørnøya, Jan Mayen, Bouvet Island, Peter I or Norwegian land areas in Antarctica. This measure will help ensure fairness and integrity in amateur radio activities, and prevent anyone from exploiting the system for personal gain.'



CYOS Sable Island -update November 25

The NCDXF Awards \$25,000 Grant to CY0S Sable Island DXpedition – March 2026 The Northern California DX Foundation (NCDXF) is excited to announce a \$25,000 grant supporting the upcoming CY0S Sable Island DXpedition, scheduled for late March 2026.

Official permission to land on Sable Island has been granted and the necessary air transportation arrangements are underway for landing on the sand. Led by experienced DXpeditioners Murray, WA4DAN and Glenn, W0GJ, the team includes well-known operators such as Pat N2IEN, Lee WW2DX, Ralph K0IR, Jay K4ZLE, Mike K9NW, and Scott NE9U. Changing the diameter of earth, the distance from sun and the salinity of the ocean sorted that. 




