KP5/NP3VI Desecheo Island -update February 2

We are pleased to share the updated Weekly Mode Schedule for the week beginning February 2, 2026 (00:00 UTC).

Based on operating statistics and ongoing feedback from the DX community, we have made several adjustments aimed at maximizing unique QSOs, which remains the primary mission of the Desecheo DXpedition. These adjustments emphasize 10m and the higher bands, where we continue to see the greatest opportunity to put new stations and new DXCCs in the log.

 Current operating highlights (as of this update):

- Total QSOs: 52,300+
- Unique callsigns: 12,500+
- All-Time New Ones (ATNO / New DXCC impact): ~3,000 DXers
- Operating days so far: 19
- Operation continues until: February 12

4U1A Review DXCC status

At the start of 2026, the Amateur Radio Club at the Vienna International Centre (ARCDXC 4U1A) officially resumed its efforts to have our station recognized as a separate entity on the DXCC Award list.

Our Position: Our goal is not to request the creation of a “new country” based on political motives, but rather to rectify a long-standing administrative inconsistency and correct a historical error.

Currently, the DXCC program recognizes the United Nations Headquarters in New York (4U1UN) and Geneva (4U1ITU) as separate entities. However, the UN Headquarters in Vienna (4U1A)—which possesses an identical legal status of extraterritoriality, its own United Nations Postal Administration (UNPA), and full administrative independence from the host nation’s regulatory body—continues to be erroneously classified as part of Austria.

CY0S Sable Island -update

Six weeks today, CY0S team members will begin their travels to Halifax, Nova Scotia. Weather remains the focal point of the CY0S team members’ attention right now. The team knows that the weather on Sable will be a challenge. This was certainly the case on the March 2023 CY0S

DXpedition. The team are currently watching the “bomb cyclone” off the east coast of the US. This storm is forecast to have a major impact on the Canadian Maritimes and Sable Island. The team has been preparing for 40 to 50 knot winds, and frequent snow showers, which are a common occurrence on Sable in March. Since there are no trees on the island, there isn’t anything to block the fierce winds off the north Atlantic.



HR, HONDURAS Gerard, F2JD is operating as HR5/call from Copan until March. Activity on HF using CW, SSB and FT4/8. QSL via F6AJA direct or bureau.

J5, GUINEA-BISSAU Last active in January '25, Livio, IZ3BUR is again QRV as J52EC until early March. Look for him on 10 & 15m SSB. QSL via IZ3BUR (direct only).

KP5, DESECHEO ISL In collaboration with the Vieques Island Amateur Radio Club (NP3VI) and the Manyana DX Foundation, a landmark DXpedition to Desecheo Island (KP5), currently ranked as the 14th most wanted DXCC entity worldwide. To ensure continuous, global on-air presence, two self-sustained Remote Deployable Units (RDUs) provided by the Manyana DX Foundation are deployed on the island. These stations are operating 24 hours a day for 30 consecutive days, utilizing state-of-the-art remote operating infrastructure from Remote Ham Radio (RHR).

The primary mission of this DXpedition is to provide an All-Time New One (ATNO) to as many amateur radio operators worldwide as possible. Operators from Puerto Rico and international locations will participate to maximize coverage, band availability, and global accessibility.


