### DX News

#### **NCDXF DXcellence Award Winner**

For the 50th anniversary of the Northern California DX Foundation in 2021, NCDXF announced the creation of an award – *The DXcellence Award*. To be awarded to the outstanding DXpedition of the last twelve months, which received funding from NCDXF. The award is intended to recognize excellence in a DXpedition, exemplified by practices, ethics, management, new technology, transparency, youth involvement and impact upon the DXing community, and lastly, exhibited FUN!

The winner of the award is determined by the NCDXF Board of Directors at their annual meeting. The board considers several factors, including performance, complexity of the DXpedition, impact on Club Log most wanted ranking.

This year, the fifth anniversary of the award, NCDXF is proud to award two DXcellence Awards.

1. The **KP5/NP3VI** Desecheo DXpedition for it's 100% solar powered, 100% remote operation, proving that a new technology can provide a huge impact to DXing with almost no environmental impact.
2. The **PJ6Y** Youth DXpedition to Saba Island for the outstanding performance of a well-organized DXpedition that emphasized youth participation and remote radio technology. The NCDXF looks forward to other DXpeditions this year that will qualify for the next award in 2027. We are hopeful that many DXpeditions will be funded by NCDXF and qualify for this award.



#### **Z66SP Kosovo -update**

Since early April, intensive preparations have been underway for our trip to Kosovo. One of the steps was setting up three antennas that we planned as the main ones. The antennas have been assembled, adjusted and tested. There is also a dish for QO-100. The antennas are ready to go. We set up each antenna for testing. We reviewed the assembly instructions, verified that all components were present, and most importantly, connect the antennas to the radio to check for proper operation. The SWR measurement results are positive, and the resonances are on the band, so we believe this part of the equipment is ready and is currently in storage awaiting packing.

**AU2M Arnala Island AS-169**

The equipment from Agatti Island (after AU7RS DXpedition) arrived in Hyderabad via Kozhikode a few days ago. Unfortunately, upon unpacking, we discovered that one large bag is missing. This bag contained a significant amount of our critical infrastructure, including our RG217, RG213, LMR400, RG58, RG6, and RG214 cables, as well as our receiving loop antennas and the Spiderbeam wire antenna. **TX9W Marquesas Islands -update April 22**

Team attempted 160 yesterday evening (local). Total of 3 QSOs. They are being heard, but receiving poorly. The flag receive antenna is ineffective. The vertical has a lot of noise on receive. Dave WD5COV doesn't think there is enough room to lay out the BOG receive antenna. They may try one more night on 160, then switch over to 80 meters. It's a difficult QTH, on a mountainside in an old volcanic caldera on the south side of the island with mountains to the north. There are no good QTHs in the Marquesas. The plan is to install the 6 meter antenna today.

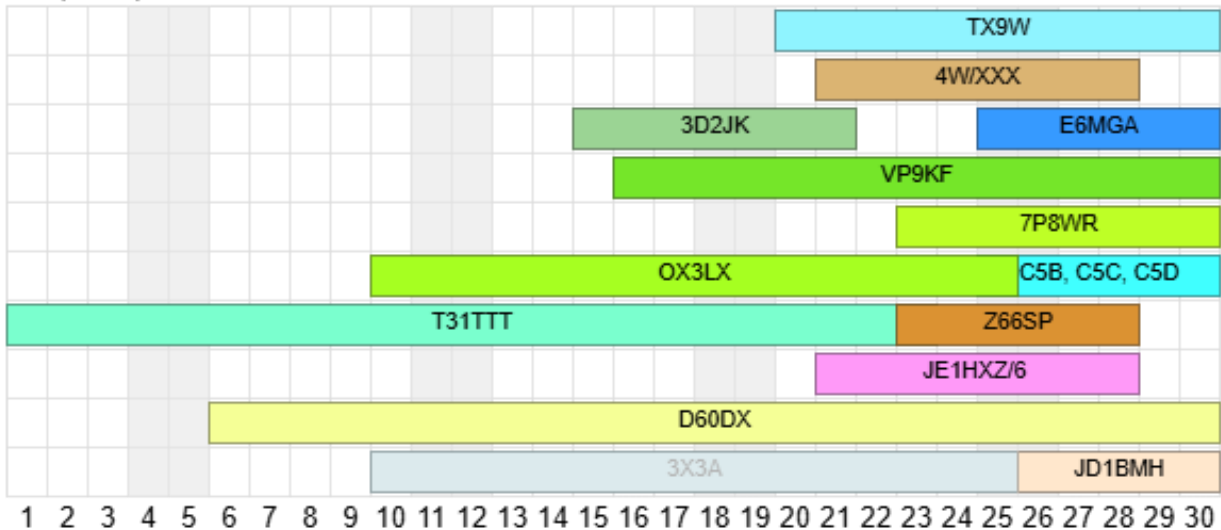
**3D2JK Lakeba Island OC-095 -now QRT by SP5APW**

The Lakeba adventure is over. During almost full days of activity I managed to log 3300 QSOs with 86 DXCC. Bands conditions were challenging. While the number of QSOs increased quite rapidly over the first two days, the last two were a struggle for every new station in the log. Last night, during four hours of SSB "operation" on 20m, I logged only eight callsigns. Well, there's no effective cure for propagation, or rather the lack thereof. Many thanks to everyone who confirmed the validity of this trip with their QSOs. Most of the equipment, including the BuddiHEX, is already packed and ready for tomorrow's flight. Currently, I'm using the last few hours of my stay on OC-095 by logging JA hams calling me on 50Mhz.

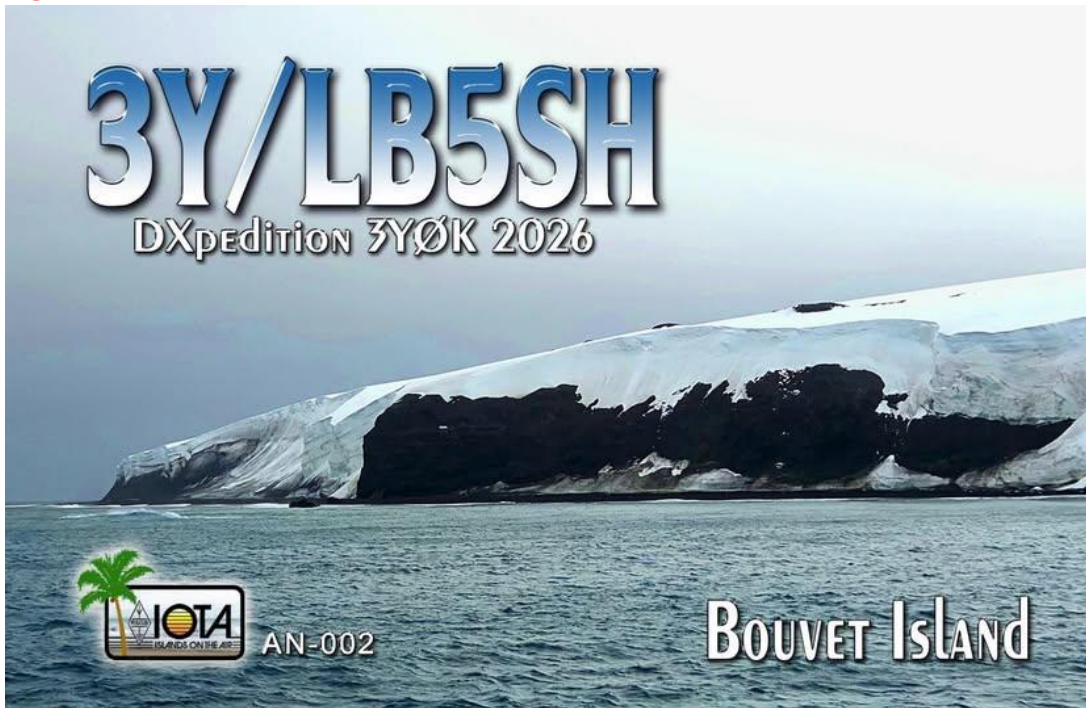

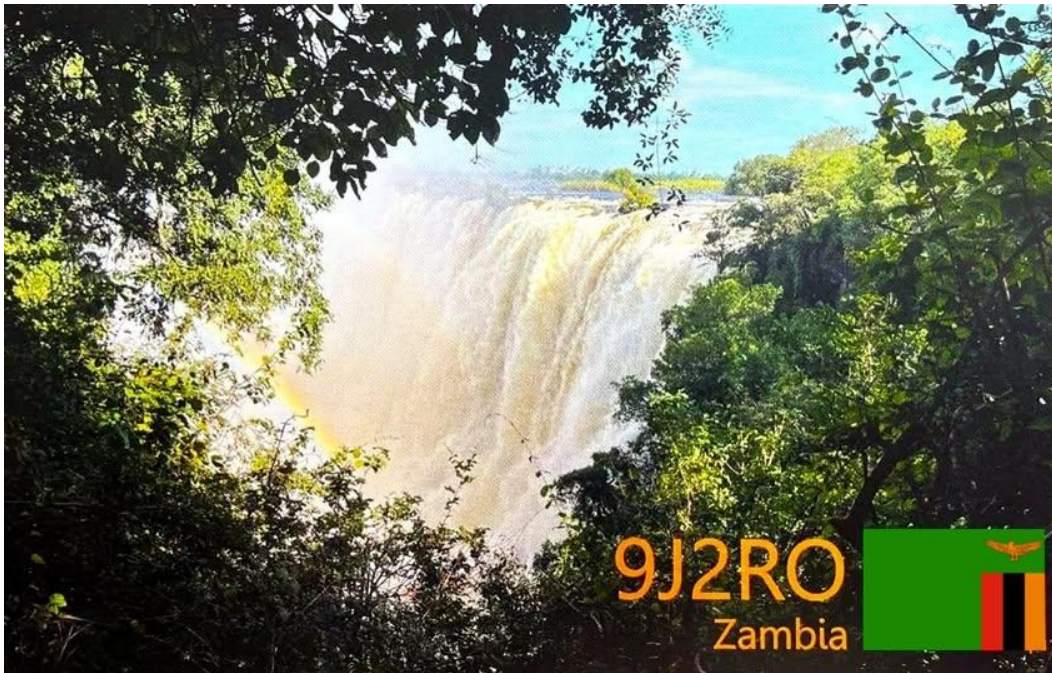

This presentation offers a behind-the-scenes look at the immense planning, logistics, weather challenges, and equipment hurdles involved in mounting a second activation of one of the rarest and most difficult DXCC entities.

**Desecheo 2026 DXpedition: The First All Solar Powered Unattended DXpedition in History. Presented by Otis Vicens, NP4G, and Ez Prado, HI3R.**

This groundbreaking presentation details the KP5 Desecheo operation, which brought the island back on the air using a fully remote, solar-powered platform. Operating unattended for more than 40 days and logging over 100,000 QSOs, the team relied on advanced power management, propagation planning, and multistream FT8 to maximize results while conserving energy. Attendees will gain insight into the technical, logistical, and personal challenges of running a world-class DXpedition remotely.

**Failures and Lessons Learned from DXing in Adverse Conditions. Presented by Paul Ewing, N6PSE.**

Not every DXpedition follows the plan. Paul Ewing shares candid stories of operations impacted by weather, equipment failures, logistics breakdowns, and human factors. This session focuses on what went wrong, what was learned, and how those experiences can help future DXpeditions better prepare for the unexpected.
