DXCC timeline

3G0Z and XR0Z Juan Fernandez Islands -update May 19

The 3G0Z operation began a couple of hours ahead of schedule. At the moment, operations are taking place on the 17m band using SSB and FT8 modes, with a single element Delta Loop antenna. Over the next few hours, I expect to continue installing the remaining antennas and bring the linear amplifier into service in order to expand the station's operating capabilities. Weather conditions on the island are somewhat unstable, with cloudy skies and occasional light rain showers; however, the temperature is quite pleasant at around 15°C (59°F). There are also periods of light wind, but nothing to be concerned about.

The location selected for the antenna installation is approximately 40 meters above sea level, with an excellent takeoff toward Europe, Africa, and the central United States, providing good propagation prospects.



Danjo Islands AS-056 JI3DST/6 and JA4GXS/6 -cancelled

We had planned an IOTA operation from the Danjyo Islands (AS-056), but due to anticipated severe weather conditions such as strong winds and heavy rain, the fishing vessel we planned to use has been forced to cancel its operations.

Therefore, we regret to inform you that we have had to cancel this operation.

We sincerely apologize to everyone who was looking forward to the operation, and to everyone who has provided support and cooperation.

We ask for your understanding that this decision was made with safety as our top priority.

Japan has entered the rainy season, making the resumption of operations extremely difficult, but we will strive to resume operations as soon as possible.

Tutumate Islands SA-093 HK4/PY8WW by Renato

After a long period of logistical planning, I finally decided to activate Titumate Island, IOTA SA-093, one of the most wanted island groups in South America. What initially looked like a simple expedition quickly turned into months of preparation, countless e-mails exchanged with local boat owners, fishermen, and contacts from the region, all necessary to make this operation possible. The journey began on May 9th, departing from Belém, Pará — the famous “PY8 land” in northern Brazil. From Belém, I took a 3 hour and 50 minute flight to Bogotá, capital of Colombia (HK). From Bogotá, another domestic flight brought me to Montería. The original plan was to continue by road toward Turbo, but earlier this year, in February, severe flooding heavily damaged the road between Montería and Turbo, including several bridges that remain compromised.

Only four women are members of the DX Hall of Fame, and Elvira is the first one inducted exclusively for her DX operating achievements.

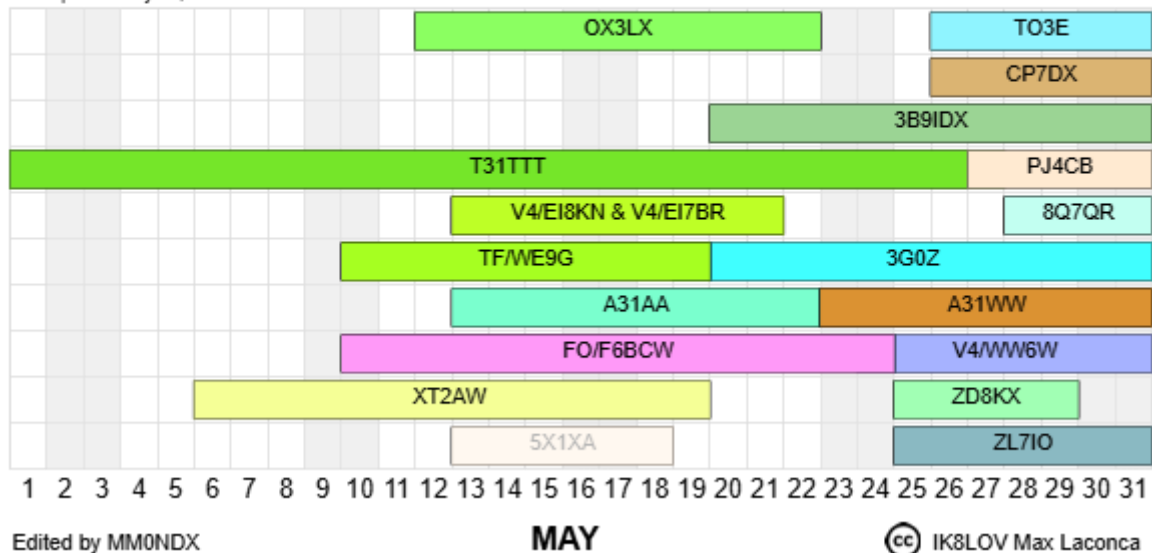

Sable Island National Park Reserve - Sable Island is a tiny crescent of shaggy sand located at the edge of the continental shelf, approximately 200 km east of Halifax, Nova Scotia. The island is home to 400 horses, tens of thousands of gull chicks, with unique plants and birds, including the spruce sparrow, which breeds almost exclusively on Sable.

Over the centuries, Sable Island has been the site of more than 250 shipwrecks, hence the name "Graveyard of the Atlantic" is very fitting. Fragments of these shipwrecks frequently appear in the shifting sand. The CYOS team observed signs of the remains of these vessels. The weather conditions during our March 2026 Expedition were very changeable with strong gale force winds, rain and occasional snow showers. There are no trees on the island to block the wind. Marine gear and other equipment kept outside the horse population during the long, bleak winter months. We were treated to a few sunny days which were much appreciated on this windswept island.

Sable Island is approximately 43 km long and 1.5 km wide at the widest point. Sable is very narrow in most areas. The landscape is very changeable due to strong, westerly winds, and storms have had a dramatic impact on the island. Occasionally, tropical systems pass near or over the island. The Sable Station is equipped with two automatic weather stations, and 4m-cm.

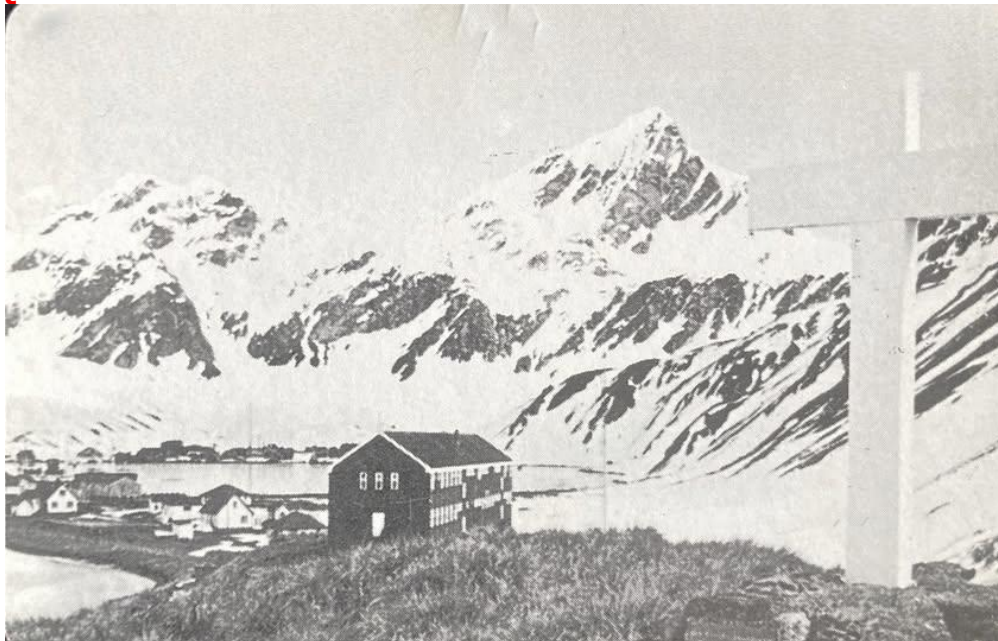

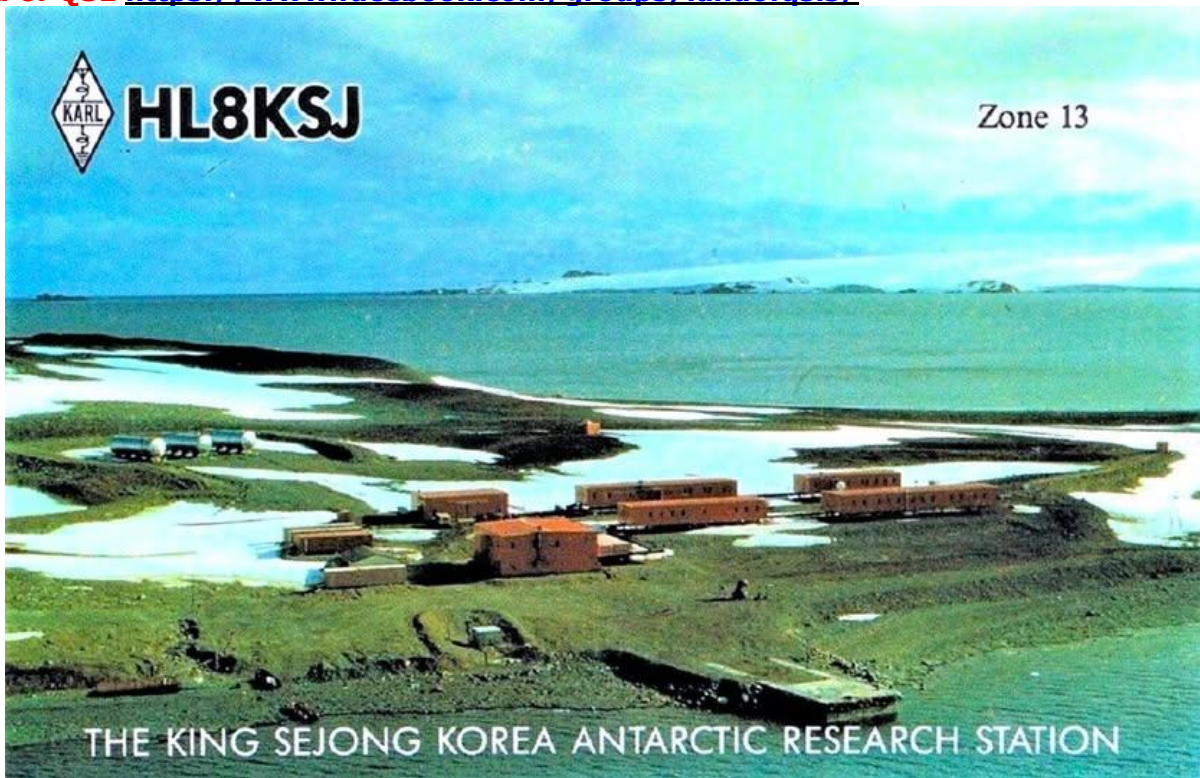

Lost islands 25th anniversary activity

From May 21 to May 31, the "Lost Islands - Days of Activity / 25" will take place. Organized by the Russian Robinson International Club, the event is dedicated to Polar Explorer's Day and the 25th anniversary of the "Lost Islands" High-Latitude Arctic Radio Expedition.

During the Days of Activity, special anniversary call signs will be active on the air: **RA25LI** (Novosibirsk), **RN25LI** (Norilsk), and **RD25LI** (Dixon Island). The suffix "LI" stands for Lost Islands.

Participants who accumulate 25 points and establish contacts with at least two of the anniversary radio stations will be awarded commemorative certificates, while those who complete QSOs with

all three stations will receive commemorative plaques. Five points are awarded for each radio contact. Duplicate contacts are valid if made on different bands or using different modes (SSB, CW, DIGI).

Any missing contact with an anniversary station may be substituted by a QSO with one of the call signs from the 2001 "Lost Islands" expedition—RI0B, RU0B, or RS0B—though this substitution is permitted only once.

A special QSL card (RA25LI/RN25LI/RD25LI) will be issued for every single QSO made with any of the anniversary stations.

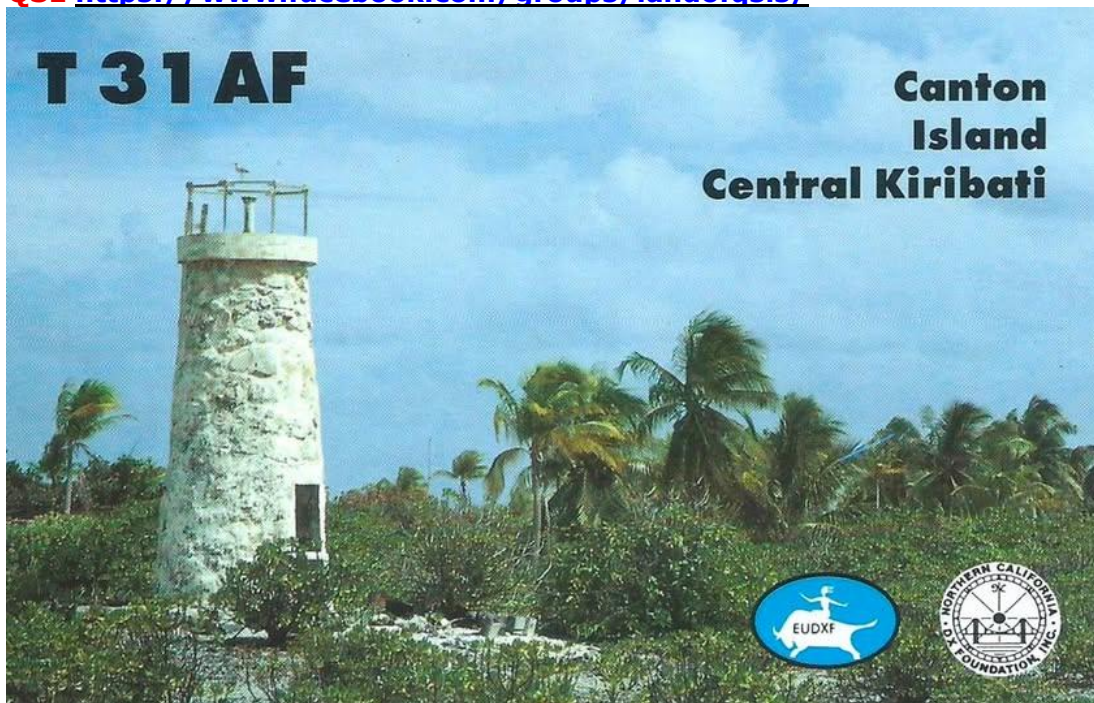
